This time of year can be filled with worry about finding the perfect Christmas gifts. Deep down we want people in our lives to know they are special and that we love them. But sometimes we overlook the greatest gift of all - our very presence.

The Gift of Being Present

During Advent and Christmas, we remember that God came to be present

among us through Jesus. How can we be more fully present this season?

Our spiritual ancestors cried out in the midst of their political occupations: "Save us!" The idea of a Messiah went hand-in-hand with the need for God to help them in their distress. The Roman occupation of Jesus' time and of the early Christian community is expressed with a sense of waiting, watching, and anticipation of restoration to freedom. All this points to the presence of hope, essential to survival in difficult times.

This week we'll consider what it means for us to have hope too, and be fully present this Christmas season with hope.

- Reviewed a draft of the new church by-laws, to be presented to the congregation for approval at the Year End Congregational Meeting.
- Called the Year End Congregational Meeting for Sunday, November 26th immediately following worship, to elect officers for 2024 and to approve new by-laws.
